Listen Up will customize workshops that will last 2-4 hours, a full day or 1-2 weeks, depending on the needs of the school or organization.



- Screen the film at an assembly or with small student groups and pair with an interactive discussion!
- Screen the film in classes and use games, and/or writing prompts to start conversations and share stories with teens.
- Host a listening party of the soundtrack and talk about the themes in the songs!



Host a 1-2 week Intensive workshop of conversation, writing and arts activities that will culminate in a "Listen Up" Pop Up performance by students.



Develop standards-aligned curriculum in specific content areas (e.g., health, social studies, English) so your educators can use the production as a learning tool in their classroom.
